Enhanced Self Service at our ITM/ATM's

We recently rolled out our Enhanced Self Service (ESS) feature on all our atm and itm's. Now, when you insert your Trius debit card into the machines, our members can see all their accounts at once (excluding certificates and IRA's), deposit cash and checks together (up to 30 items at a time), make loan payments, and withdraw up to \$3000 cash. You can also print mini statements of your last 20 transactions. Members will also be able to set preferences for fast cash, denominations, language, and receipt.
